Admission requirements

Your child...

- successfully completed the **4th grade of an elementary school** in the 2023–24 school year and
- has turned **11 years old by September 30, 2024?**



Your child can enroll in the 5th grade of a **Realschule** or a **Gymnasium**

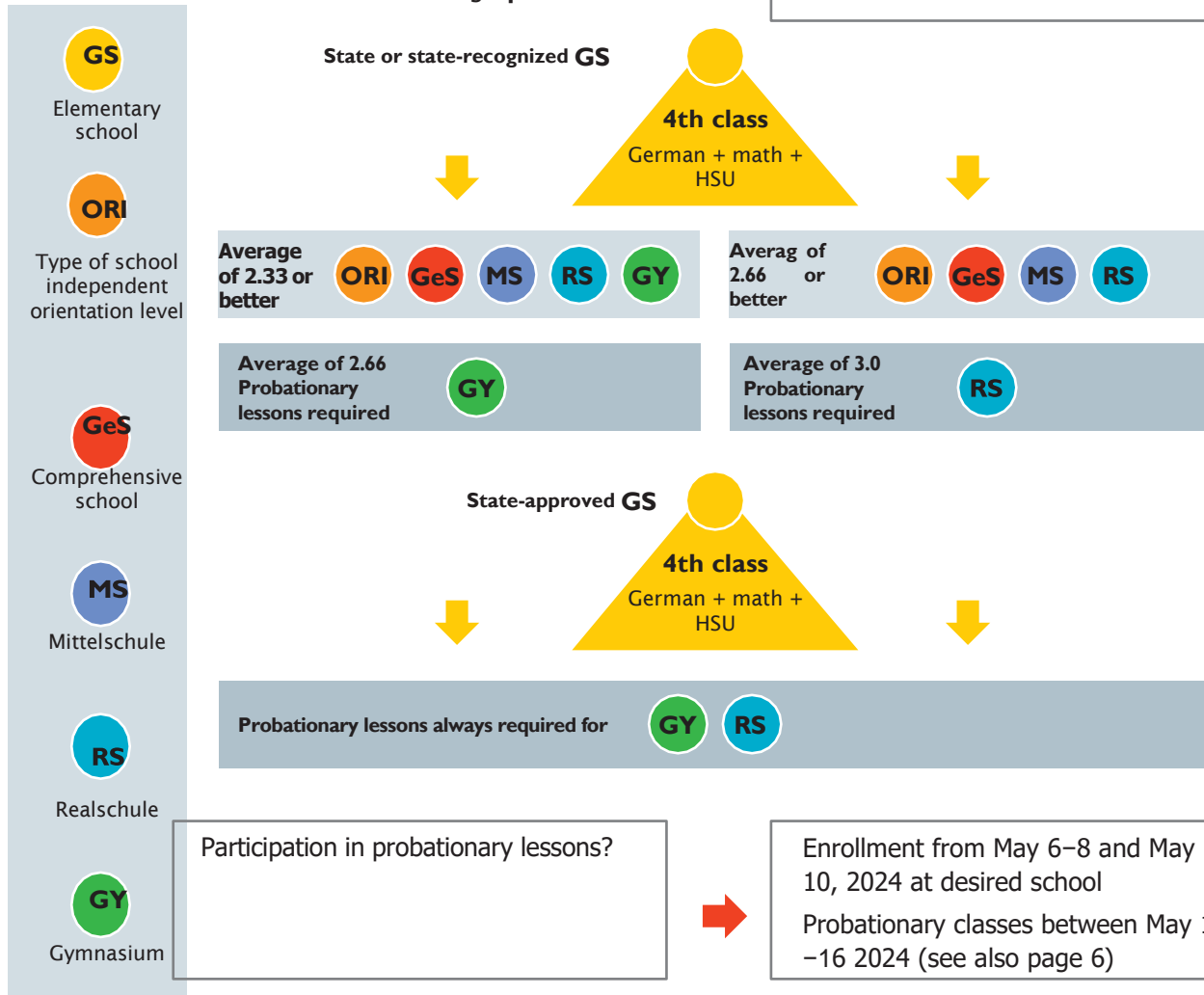


Your child can enroll in the 5th grade at a **municipal orientation program independent of school type** and the **municipal Willy Brandt Comprehensive School** (see conditions on page 7).

Transfer to a Realschule or Gymnasium is also possible after completing the 5th grade of a public or state-recognized Mittelschule under certain conditions. Transfer to a Gymnasium is also possible after completing the 5th grade of a public or state-recognized Realschule or a Mittelschule under certain conditions.

Please register your child at the school to which he or she would like to be admitted. As a rule, your child will also take part in probationary lessons at this school, if necessary. Further information on this can be obtained from the school (see also chapters 5 and 6).

Enrollment can only be made by a parent or legal guardian or their authorized representative. As a rule, the signature of a parent or legal guardian is sufficient.

- Certificate of a partial performance disorder, if applicable

Acceptance

Your child is invited to attend 5th grade at the beginning of the school year at a municipal or state Gymnasium or Realschule.

Academic secondary schools (Gymnasien)

If your child does not receive a placement at the school of your choice, the respective school administrator will make every effort to find a suitable place for your child at another Gymnasium. There is no entitlement to admission to a specific Gymnasium in Munich.

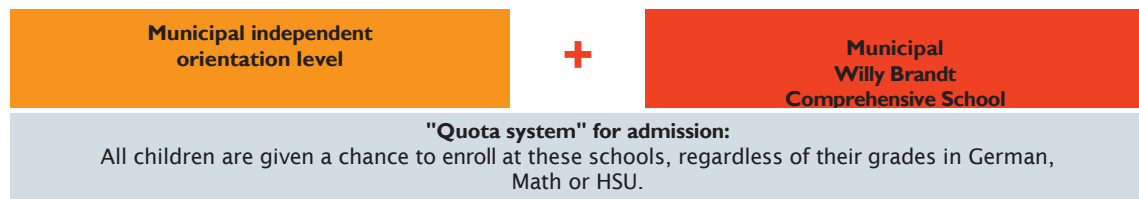
Vocational secondary schools (Realschulen)

If your child does not receive a placement at the school of your choice, an effort will be made to find a suitable place at another public Realschule in the metropolitan area. There is no entitlement to admission to a specific Realschule in Munich.

Non-university track secondary schools (Mittelschulen)

The dates for pre-registration for certain Mittelschulen offers such as all-day programs, practical classes or M-classes can be found on the homepage of the State Education Authority at school authority www.schulamt-muenchen.musin.de.

Schools of a special kind



Allocation of places at the **municipal independent orientation level in Munich-Neuperlach:**

Group A: 60 places (20%) for students with an average grade of 1.00 to 2.33

Group B: 90 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 2.66

Group C: 90 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 3.00 and 3.33

Group D: All students who do not belong to groups A, B and C. This includes students with a grade point average of 3.66 or higher and students from state-approved schools or students from state elementary school without a transfer certificate

Allocation of places at the **Municipal Willy Brandt comprehensive school:**

Group A: 32 places (20%) for students with an average grade of 1.00 to 2.33

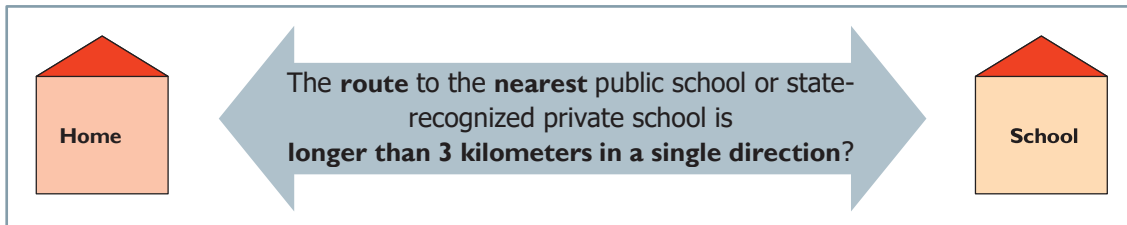
Group B: 48 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 2.66

Group C: 48 places (30%) for students with an average grade of 3.00 and 3.33

Group D: 32 places (20%) for students with an average grade of 3.66 or higher

If more children are enrolled in the individual groups than there are places, a **lottery will be held**. It will take place at the Willy Brandt Comprehensive School on the day of enrollment, **Friday, May 3, 2024**, at 7 pm. The draw at the Munich-Neuperlach Municipal Independent Orientation School will take place on **Tuesday, May 7, 2024**, at 9 am. If your child **does not** get a **place**, you can enroll them at a Gymnasium or Realschule until **Friday, May 10, 2024** if the transfer certificate shows the appropriate aptitude. This is also the case if you submit a hardship application after a rejection, which will only be decided on later.

Free commute to and from school



You can **apply to have the cost** of your public transport **ticket** (bus, streetcar, underground and suburban train) **covered**.
As a rule, this applies to the school that can be reached at the lowest cost.
Exceptions can be approved by the Department of Education and Sports.

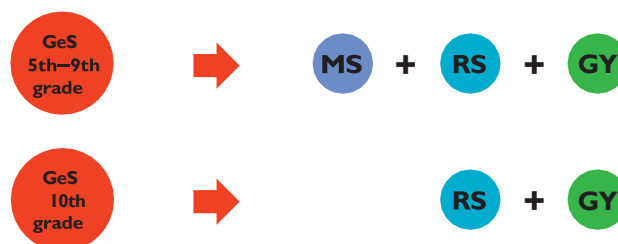
Municipal independent orientation level Munich-Neuperlach

Willy Brandt comprehensive school

At the Willy Brandt Comprehensive School, students can achieve the secondary school leaving certificate, the intermediate secondary school leaving certificate and the upper secondary school leaving certificate in science and technology.



From grades 5 to 7, students attend a common core group (class). When they enter grade 8, the students decide whether they can complete the secondary school leaving certificate or the intermediate secondary school leaving certificate or whether they choose to achieve the upper secondary school leaving certificate for the science and technology track. In this case, the students attend the 11th grade at the Municipal Willi-Graf-Gymnasium.
